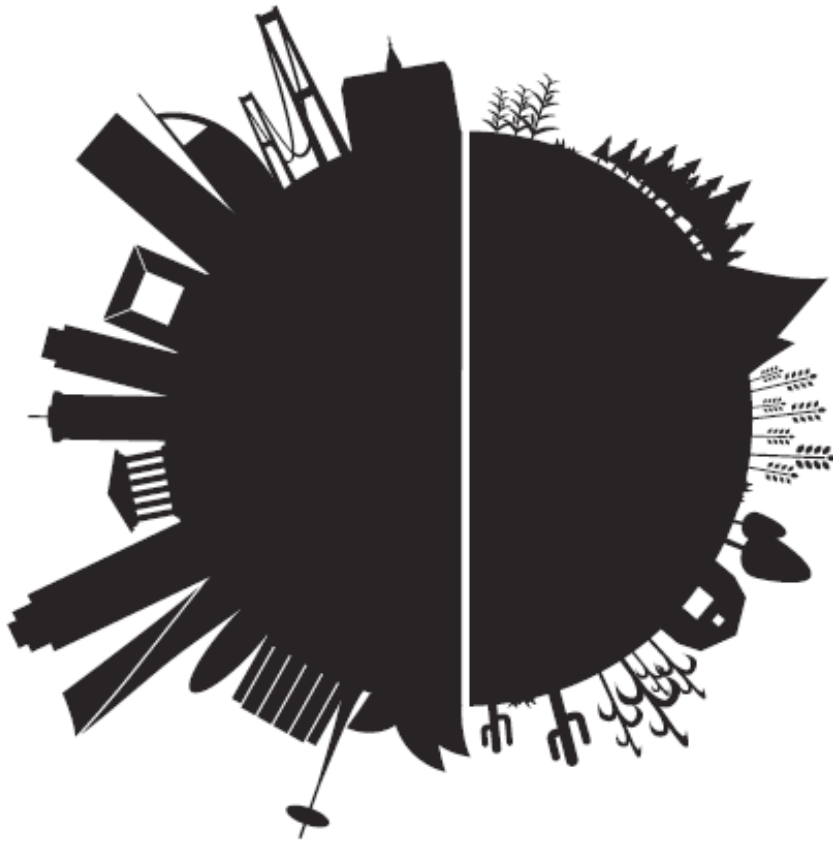

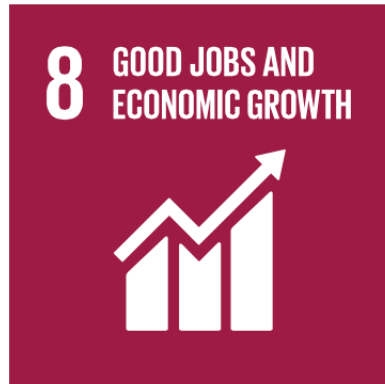
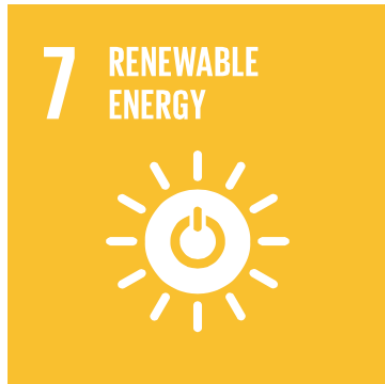

Habitat III Ultimate Goal New Urban Agenda

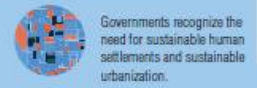
The NUA has been many month and many meetings underway, from the Zero Draft first unveiled in May 2016 to where it is now.

Vancouver 1976 HABITAT I



Governments recognize the need for sustainable human settlements and sustainable urbanization.

World leaders adopted the Habitat Agenda as a global plan of action for adequate shelter for all, with the notion of sustainable human settlements driving development in an urbanizing world.

- a. Cities are the engines of global growth;
- b. Urbanization is an opportunity;
- c. Call for a stronger role of local authorities and
- d. Recognition of the power of participation.
